I. RESULTS

ORGANIZATION AND INTERINSTITUTIONAL SOCIAL CARE

- We continue to join efforts to strengthen the rights and prominence of our young people in all areas, working with the **178 Inter-institutional Commissions** formed to provide comprehensive care and development for youth in the Municipalities and Departmental Capitals of the Country and Districts of Managua.
- We held **4,089 inter-institutional meetings involving 51,823 people**, in order to coordinate care for adolescents with behavioral difficulties.
- We strengthened the operations of the **760 committees of fathers and mothers** for peace, who provide follow-up and accompaniment with the families of the youth and adolescent

protagonists, in the processes developed under the program.

- We trained **394,031** mothers and fathers in **687** sessions with topics related to "Prevention of Addictions", Strengthening of values, Assertive communication, recognizing the importance of being alert to signs that indicate that their daughters and sons are having addiction problems and acquiring the commitment to strengthen communication.
- We continue to serve the targeted territories, prioritizing 15 municipalities: Managua, Tipitapa, Ciudad Sandino, Estelí, Nueva Segovia, Masaya, Granada, Matagalpa, RACCS, Rivas, Madriz, Jinotega, León, Chinandega and Carazo; 421 neighborhoods, 118 in Managua and 303 in the country's Departments. Likewise we carryout preventive actions in 31 municipalities: San Juan de Río Coco, San Lucas, Telica, Santa Rosa del Peñón,

La Paz Centro, Nagarote, Achuapa, El Jicaral, El Sauce, Larreynaga, El Viejo, Chichigalpa, Quezalaguaque, Masatepe, La Concepción, Nindirí, Catarina, Tisma, Niquinohomo, Nandasmo, Teustepe, Santa Lucía, San Lorenzo, El Coral, El Rama, Acoyapa, El Castillo, San Carlos, Morrito, San Miguelito and San Juan de Nicaragua. We continue attending **433 youth-at-risk-groups**, made up of 6,025 young people, 87.5% of whom are men, which is equivalent to 5,277 and 12.5% (748), women, selected according to risk factors.

- We guarantee **attention to 4,562 prioritized educational centers** nationwide selected for diagnoses of violence and risk factors.

- We made **91,280 house-to-house visits to 316,880 adolescents and young people**, motivating them to join sports and cultural activities.
- We developed **4,209 sessions and/or meetings involving 9,830 people, including religious leaders and mothers and/or parents** of young people identified as vulnerable / or at social risk, with the aim of promoting and transmitting the actions and programs of the GRUN related to violence prevention, crime reduction, alcohol and drug consumption, as well as knowing the social situation of these young people in their neighborhoods.

COMMUNITY POLICE RELATIONSHIP.

(TERRITORIAL NETWORK) .

We strengthen a Healthy, Educated and Capable youth through specialized care, to lead them to a culture of peace and reconciliation.

- We provided **20,355 Specialized Services to 27,690 young people** to provide tools and resist addictions, through the Directorate of Youth Affairs of the National Police and the Heads of Sectors.
- We provide Mental health care and treatment with psychologists to 89 adolescents and Youth, in health units, to overcome their problems and addictions.
- We guarantee **Control and follow-up to 246 adolescents and young people with non-custodial precautionary measures**, from Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10 of Managua and Departments of Chontales, Carazo, León and RACCN.
- We referred **190 young people and adolescents to rehabilitation centers for drug addictions, use and abuse.**

- We gave **1,598 Municipal Workshops to 92,816 Participants** in the areas of: Promotion of Values, Unity and Community and Family Coexistence, self-esteem, self-care and prevention of drug and alcohol consumption.
- We trained **145 Youth Affairs officers and psychosocial personnel at the national level** in institutional accompaniment for girls, boys, adolescents and young people in situations of drug addictions.
- In coordination with the Supreme Court of Justice, we trained **43 officers of the National Police and psychosocial personnel** in the subject of restorative justice for young people who have broken the law.
- We carried out 51,033 coverage of activities on weekends, including: 16,730 sports, 12,468 cultural activities, 6,016 assemblies

with the community, 6,200 gastronomic and family economy fairs, 612 walks (walk for Peace, walk for the lives of women and walk in love that can do everything and overcome everything, walk in support of the countries affected by COVID 19), 3,208 visits to tourism destinations and spas, 897 health fairs, 1,229 religious activities, 976 festivals, 73 patron saint festivities, 61 bullfights, 25 horse riding events and 2,282 visits to producers.

- We implemented 134,183 preventive police plans and intelligence investigations, with 13,000 participants, to strengthen community structures for social crime prevention, obtaining as a result: 193,557 people detained, 139,249 vehicles seized and 1,787 vehicles occupied, 6,604 visits to educational center directors, coordination with 6,376 parents, 16,825 students and 4,047 teachers.

- We seized 1,278 illegal firearms, thwarted 13,767 criminal outbreaks, of which 9,642 were disarticulated, and 699 recipients of stolen objects (caps) were disarticulated, to prevent violence and the most dangerous crimes.
- We executed 6,739 operations against drug outlets in the country's neighborhoods, achieving their disarticulation and seizing 21 kilograms and 79 grams of cocaine, 18 kilograms and 73 grams of Crack and 1,365,200.62 pounds of marijuana, 66,110 marijuana plants and 10,487 seeds, avoiding that they reach our youth. 126,474 doses of cocaine, 1,084,380 doses of crack and 2,476,978,339 doses of marijuana.
- As a result of monitoring 14 gangs:
 - 10 gangs were disarticulated.

- Capture of 43 leaders and 23 gang members.
- 102 are in the process of reintegration, being inserted into sports, psychosocial and community activities.
- 11 gang members incorporated into technical and vocational learning programs.
- 1 referred to a Rehabilitation Center.
- 9 reintegrated into family and work activities.

At the end of the period, we registered 4 gangs made up of 53 young people to which we continue to provide monitoring and control.

- We carried out **4,828** Meetings with **302,026 Community Participants**, among young people with behavioral difficulties, high school students and parents in order to promote Values, Unity and Community Coexistence, self-care, prevention of drug consumption

and self-esteem by publicizing the work that takes place in the Youth Training and Development Center "YOUTH".

- We held **2,671 Assemblies with the participation of 51,080 protagonists of the Community**, to learn about the problems of Youth, provide specialized care and the opportunity to enter formal education and technical courses.
- We gave **16,705 Talks aimed at 226,953 People**, emphasizing the Prevention of Social Risks, Family Coexistence and Values, use of Technologies, care and self-care, Prevention of Psychosocial Risks.
- We held **2,793 Conversations with the theme: "Promotion of Values" aimed at 45,347 people** in order to promote healthy recreation without vices.

- **1,863** training workshops for parents benefiting **114,756** protagonists with the aim of strengthening, values, assertive communication and a culture of peace.
- We developed the promotion and dissemination of the work carried out with the adolescent and youth through the delivery of **1,578 flyers, 50 posters, 333 booklets on violence prevention, 236 television publications, 12 posts, 5 campaigns and 21 appearances in the media.**

YOUTH CULTURE, CULTURE OF PEACE.

We consolidate our model of Culture, Reconciliation, Unity and Peace, restoring the rights of our adolescents and youth.

- We performed:

- **3,991 Cultural Activities with 536,102 participants;** mural designs, poetry, reforestation, cleaning of parks and fields in prevention of violence and drugs
 - **2,869 recreational activities with 228,158 participants;** Piñatas, singing, dance contests and recreational spaces.
 - **9,732 Sports Activities with the participation of 486,119 People;** Chess, Basketball, Field and indoor soccer, Baseball, Kickball.
 - **1,067 religious activities with 95,035 participants** among youth, parents and community leaders, on strengthening Christian values and the culture of peace.
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- We organized **441 community and vocational fairs** for the promotion and dissemination of the available technical training programs with the participation of **103,287 protagonists** of INATEC and the Youth Service Center of the National Police.

- We developed **2,060 care and self-care campaigns** in communities, 358 neighborhoods, in 130 municipalities with **82,596 protagonists**.
- We provided **27,360 Community Counseling Sessions to 186,522 People**, promoting values for a culture of coexistence in harmony and equity, parenting styles and prevention of violence, family treatment and support for people with addictions, families with problems of alcoholism and addiction to drugs.
- We carried out **4,111 trainings, guaranteeing the attention and preparation of 156,180 students** on topics such as: "Prevention of drug use", "I resist and prevent entry into an at risk group and I strengthen the principles and values of students at educational centers and young people with behavioral difficulties."

- **We organized 388 dance workshops at the national, regional and municipal levels, with the participation of 12,293 people, including instructors and students of Municipal Dance Schools. Likewise, 14 auditions were held to open new schools.**
- We formed 65 emergency response brigades in the Achuapa, El Jicaral, Larreynaga and Tipitapa municipalities, made up of 1,664 young people, who link our youth, for disaster prevention, social assistance in critical cases, environmental cleaning activities, park care and preservation.
- 602 youth networks were formed, linking our youth to disaster prevention, social assistance in critical cases, environmental cleaning activities, care and park preservation.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

- 260 Adolescents and Youths started the 2020 school year at the Training and Development Center "YOUTH" of the National Police.
- **6,744 young people were reintegrated into the Educational system,** in Managua, León, RACCS and Granada.
- 25 Adolescents and Youth integrated into Technical courses, 3 to the educational system of the EBA LEVELS program and 13 to the Walter Mendoza Martínez Police Academy.
- We have provided close support to 5,458 high school students identified as being at risk, through home visits, strengthening the family-school bond and establishing curricular adaptations for students with special educational needs, in order to contribute to their retention, permanence

and continuity within the educational system and **375** young people have been supported with a scholarship in the municipalities of Ciudad Sandino, El Jicaral, El Rama, Larreynaga, Managua, Mateare, Nagarote, Telica, Ticuantepe and Tipitapa.

- **888 Adolescents and Youths were integrated into Technical Courses** in the Departments of Managua, Matagalpa, Rivas, León, Nueva Segovia and Zelaya Central, in 35 technical careers, distributed in 853 training courses related to: Residential electricity, motorcycle repair, repair of cell phones, auto mechanics, welding, surveying, beauty, accounting, English, computing and basic cooking.
- We accompanied 12,043 young people, by conducting 559 workshops and talks related to entrepreneurial culture, creative economy,

association, product aggregation and transformation, establishment of family gardens and elaboration of artisan bio-inputs.

- Of the young people identified as being at risk in schools, 7,886 adolescents and young people have been accompanied and followed up and remain active in the Educational System.
- We included 1,919 young people in courses at Trade Schools, in the municipalities of Achuapa, El Jicaral, Larreynaga, Nagarote, Managua, Ciudad Sandino, Tipitapa and Villa El Carmen.
- We guarantee accompaniment to 3,671 young entrepreneurs, in order to access Entrepreneurship Programs, of which 156 have already been capitalized, with an amount of C \$ 3,425,000 córdobas, to guarantee the proper execution of their investment plans in the municipalities

of Jinotega, San Lorenzo, Tipitapa, Managua, Telica, Quezalguaque, León, Larreynaga, El Jicaral, Jinotega and Madriz.

- We provided 151 trainings in attention to 8,658 young entrepreneurs, with the following activities:
 - ✓ Entrepreneurial Culture Training and Entrepreneurship Program in the field, on the theme: Living a life without drugs, Entrepreneurship and how to be a good entrepreneur.
 - ✓ Practical workshop in making cakes and marango wine, pineapple jam and fostering the entrepreneurial spirit.
 - ✓ Promotion and encouragement of creative ventures.
 - ✓ Poultry farming, making rag dolls, wood crafts, furniture and shoe stores.

- ✓ Promotion of creative ventures in the family economy.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

With the implementation of the Inter-institutional Program of comprehensive care for adolescents and youth in the period from January 1 to July 23, 2020, the following has been achieved:

- **394,031** mothers and fathers trained in "Addiction Prevention" issues, recognizing the importance of being alert to signs that their children are having addiction problems and acquiring the commitment to strengthen communication.
- **4,828 Meetings with 302,026 Community Participants**, among young with behavioral difficulties, high school students and

parents in order to Promote Values, Community Unity and Coexistence, self-care, drug consumption prevention and self-esteem by publicizing the work that It takes place at the Youth Training and Development Center "YOUTH".

- **1,863** Training workshops for parents benefiting **114,756** protagonists with the aim of strengthening, values, assertive communication and a culture of peace.
- **9,732 Sports Activities with the participation of 486,119 youth;** Chess, Basketball, Field and indoor soccer, Baseball, Kickball.
- **91,280 visits home to home, to 316,880 adolescents and young people,** motivating them to join sports and cultural activities.
- **1,067 religious activities with 95,035 participants** among youth, parents, community

leaders in strengthening Christian values and the culture of peace.

- **441** community and vocational fairs for the promotion and dissemination of the offer of technical training with the participation of **103,287 protagonists** of the INATEC and in the Youth Training and Development Center "YOUTH" of the National Police.
- **6,744** young people reintegrated into the educational system.
- **156** young entrepreneurs were capitalized, with C\$ **3,425,000.00** Córdoba, in order to execute their investment plans.
- **20,355 Specialized Services to 27,690 young people** to provide tools and resist addictions, through the Directorate of Youth Affairs of the National Police and Heads of Sectors.

- 134,183 preventive police plans, police intelligence and investigations with the occupation of 1,278 illegal firearms, we harassed 13,767 criminal outbreaks, of which we disarticulated 9,642, we also disarticulated 699 recipients of stolen objects (fence), for the prevention of violence and the most dangerous crimes
- We executed 6,739 operations against drug outlets in the country's neighborhoods, achieving their disarticulation and seizing 21 kilograms and 79 grams of cocaine, 18 kilograms, 73 grams of Crack and 1,365,200.65 pounds of marijuana, 66,110 marijuana plants and 10,487 seeds, avoiding to reach our youth, 126,474 doses of cocaine, 1,084,380 doses of crack and 2,476,978,339 doses of marijuana.
- At the end of the period we registered 4 Youth Groups (Gangs) made up of 53 young

people who continue to provide monitoring and control in Managua.

- No homicides are reported for confrontation of youth groups or gangs in the period from January **1** to July **23**, 2020.
- The departmental and municipal capitals did not report gang confrontations on public roads, achieving the restoration of tranquility and security in the community.
